On behalf of Midleton Hockey Club we would like to thank you for your support towards our development over the past years. However we have struggled in the last few seasons especially in the Ladies section and hence we are not entering any Ladies teams to the Munster leagues. This brings its own difficulties and added pressure to committee members and to the Men's team members. We have come up with the following guidelines for members this season to ensure the smooth running of the club and for the club to continue to prosper going forward.

Club membership Fees must be paid in full before December 1st 2009

Fees cover entry to Munster League & Cup competitions, playing kit, general insurance and also other day to day running costs like Kit washing, PR, Web Site, Kids Hockey etc

Kids / Junior Hockey

We have formed a Kids Hockey committee which will provide; a structured training plan, organize registration, kit and a Rota of members that need to assist on a Saturday for 1 hour from 1:30 to 2:30pm. Members must make themselves available to assist with the coaching of Kids Hockey at least 3 sessions this season. Sessions run for 10 weeks before and 10 weeks after Christmas as per schedule below with over 60 children taking part. If your name is on the Rota and you are unable to attend you must swap with another member.

Communications, replying to Texts & Emails

Information will be sent mainly by text & email. A text will be sent to all players informing them of the venue, time, and details for a match or a change to a training session. If a reply is required the player **must** reply to these texts as soon as possible. This allows Coaches to manage matches and teams more efficiently. Members must agree that when giving phone or email details they consent to receiving communications from the Club. Contact information will not be shared with any other body, company or person.

Mouth Guards, Shin Guards

Hockey is considered a high contact sport, it is imperative that all players wear their mouth guards and shin guards for all training sessions and matches. Junior players will not be allowed on the pitch without a mouth guard. Players should consider individual insurance to cover for medical expenses such as major dental work in case of an accident. The club can advise players on this if required.
